When not flying Beth enjoys gardening and spending time with friends. She loves taking Dottie to fly-ins, Osh-Kosh and camping under the wing. She is also looking forward to working on a new boat with her sister. But whatever the challenge, Beth will surely face it head on with self assured confidence.

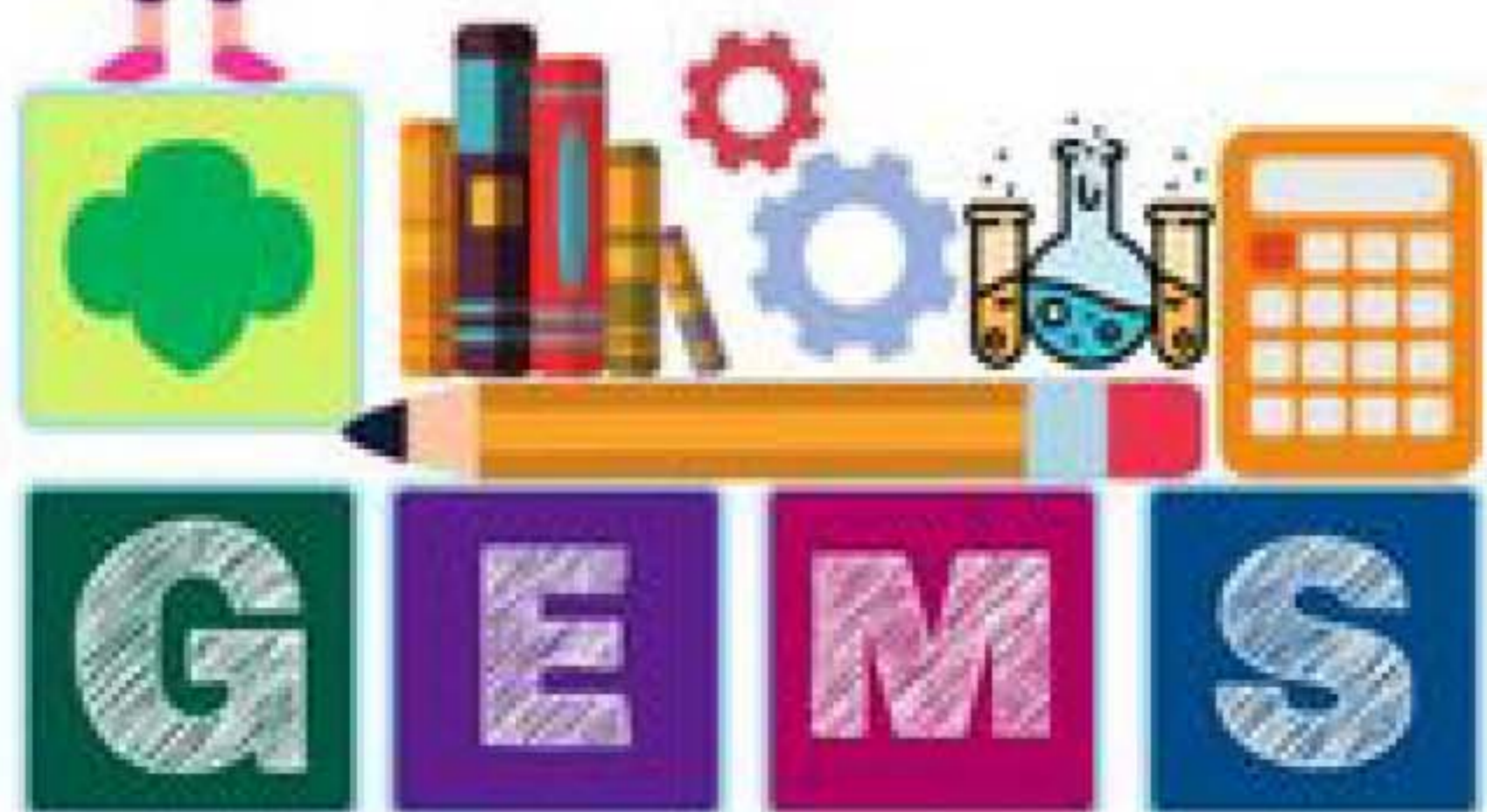
